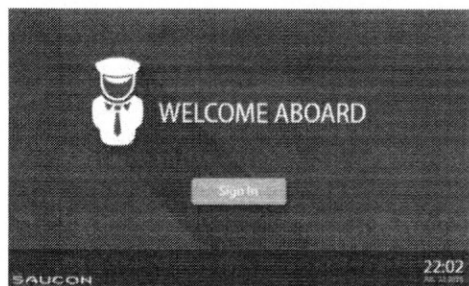




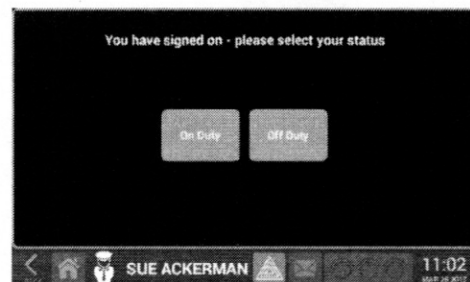
Sign in: Tap "Sign In" to log into the device.



Driver ID: Enter your Driver Id and Trip id number then tap Submit.



Status: Tap OD or OFF to set status.

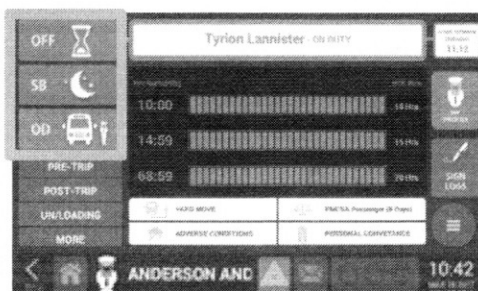

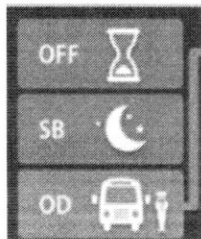
Main Console Screen: Tap Driver Logs App to view logs.

Progress Screen: Shows driver name & current status at top of screen. To change status, tap a status button.

Progress Screen: To enter a comment tap a comment from available list.

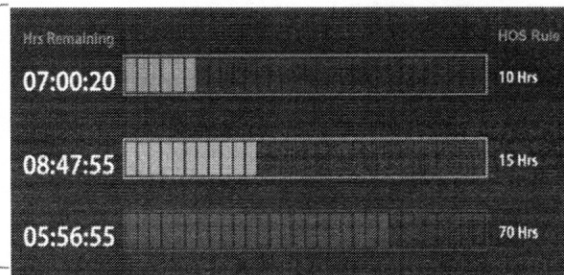

DRIVING STATUS: To change status to DRIVING, simply begin driving the vehicle. The system changes the driver's status to 'Driving' once the engine speed reached 3 mph.

Scrollable section



- To change status – simply tap the On Duty Not Driving button (OD), SB or OFF duty buttons.
- When manually adding a new duty event, the system displays a 'Driving' button to be accessed within the Add Duty Detail screen.

- Green = Remaining time is acceptable.
- Orange = Warns the Driver that their Remaining hours are getting low.
- Red = Shows the Driver that they are in danger of violating their HOS clock(s).

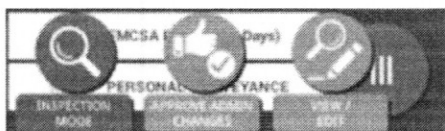
SPECIAL MODE BUTTONS:

- Tap **Yard Movement** to indicate YM, status changes to OD.
- Tap **Personal Conveyance** to note PC (must be in Off Duty)
- Tap **Adverse Conditions** to indicate A/C on log, a yellow dot is shown on graph.
- Tap **FMCSA Reg** button to select available regulation choices. Drivers must manually tap the Reg button again to revert back to original regulation set.

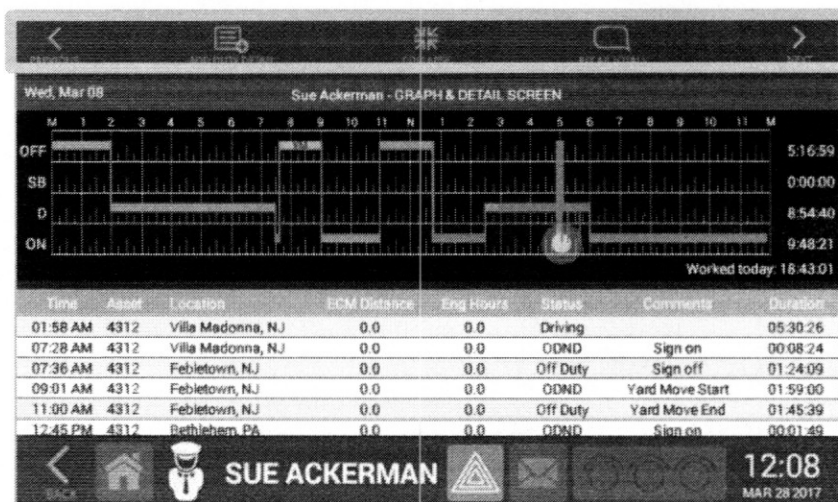

To **View/Edit** your logs, tap the red circle button to view menu additional menu icons. Tap the **VIEW/EDIT** icon.



- The top section of the screen contains various icons that drivers can use to view their log data.
- Tap **Previous / Next** buttons to view each days graph and events.
- Tap **Add Duty Detail** to add a new event to your log.
- Tap **Expand/Collapse** to show/hide duty events.
- Tap **Recap** to view the recap totals for the week.
- Current days violations are shown as red lines on graph.

To **Add** a duty event to your log, tap the **Add Duty Detail** button. In pop up screen, select the status button, and then continue to fill out all required fields. Tap Save when done.

- The system prevents drivers from adding events that would reduce electronically recorded driving time.
- Events cannot be created in the future.
- If you are currently in Driving status and you want to create an OD event for right now, you may do so as long as you are within 6 minutes of current time.

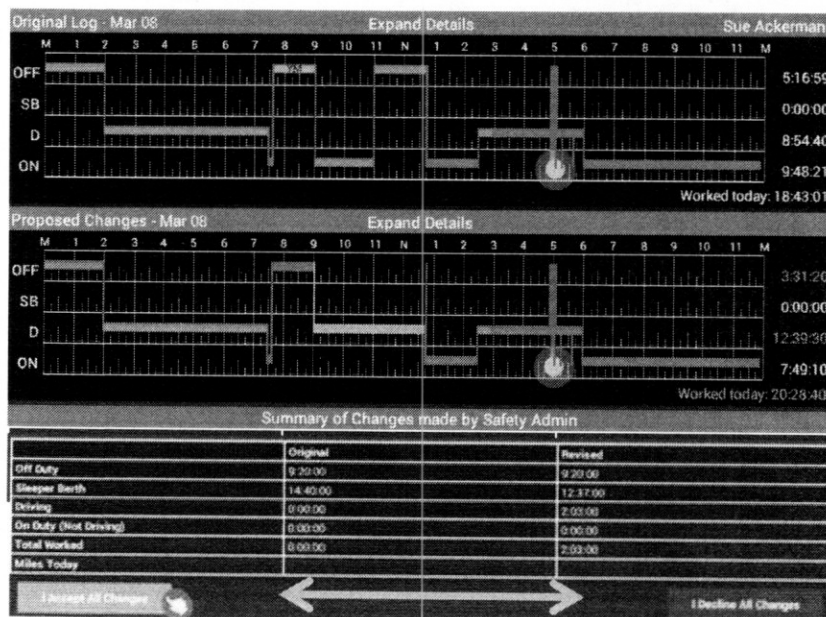

- **TIP:** If you forgot to go Off Duty last night, correct your log by adding an Off Duty event to last night's log.

To **Approve Admin Changes**: tap the red circle button then tap the Approve Admin Changes icon.

- The screen displays the Original drivers graph & events and the Proposed Changes made by the Admin. All changes made by the Admin are shown in pink.
- Tap "Expand Details" to view the duty event section.
- A Summary of Changes made to the log are displayed at the bottom of the screen. (swipe up to view)
- Drivers are required review the changes and either accept or decline the changes. Tapping "I Accept" will update the drivers log with the admin's changes. Tapping "I Decline" does not update the log with the admin's changes.



- **TIP:** All Pending Admin changes must be addressed before manually adding new events to your log.



Tap **Sign Logs** button to sign today's log and or last 7 days.

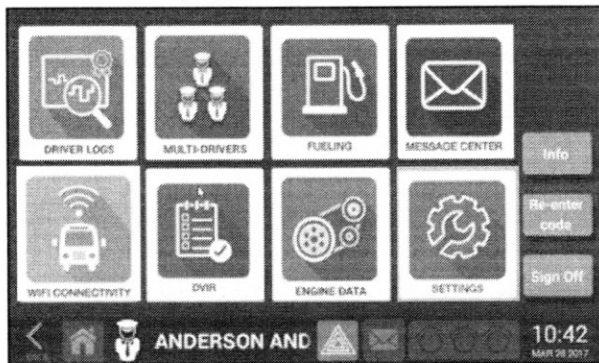
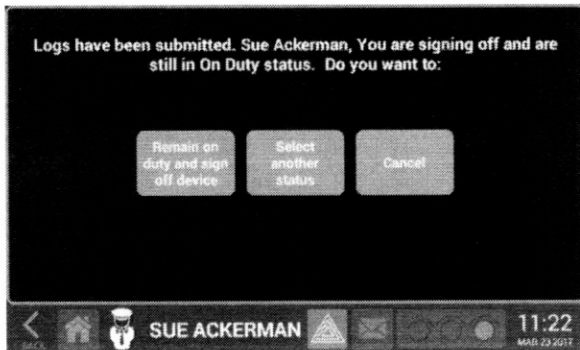

To Sign Off Properly: Drivers should sign today's log when they are done with their shift, by placing a checkmark across from today's log in the Signature screen.

- **When Signing Today's logs....**The system displays a message letting the driver know, logs have been submitted and they are signing off in a particular status, system provides status choices to select from.
- Once the driver is signed off the device their name clears from the bottom of the screen, and the Welcome Aboard screen is displayed.



- **When Signing any other day's logs....**The system does NOT sign the driver off the device. Instead the driver is brought back to the Progress screen.
- To sign off the device tap the home button at the bottom of the screen to return back to the Main Console screen, and then tap the Sign Off button.

If the driver's startup code has been cleared because the ignition has been turned off, the driver can tap the re-enter code button to enter his code and be logged back into the device.
